Established in 1974, Tolles is a career and technical school providing a launchpad for both high school students and adult learners. Located south of Plain City, Ohio, Tolles serves: Dublin, Fairbanks, Jonathan Alder, Hilliard, London, Madison-Plains, and Jefferson Local school districts. By combining bankable skills with rigorous academics Tolles continues to post uplifting results for students and the community as a whole.

In 1971, Harry E. Tolles was hired as the first superintendent of the Central Ohio Joint Vocational School District. Tolles led the efforts to get voter approval for building the school, staffing the school, and enrolling students for a 1974 opening. Tolles remained with the district until his retirement in 1984, the year the district was named for him.
